The research team is composed of 14 senior researcher from the IREGÉ laboratory, in collaboration with several external scholars. The aim of this project is to identify, within the Rhone Alpes region, the factors which may foster the SME’s growth and the appearance of intermediate size companies. In 2012, more than 600 firms have been surveyed. This results into the creation of a database reviewing the factors inducing or inhibiting the firm’s export, innovation and growth. These firms will be regularly interviewed, in order to set up an "SME Observatory in Rhone Alpes". This project also benefits from the support of institutional partners, such as the CDC, OSEO, the OFCE ...
